

Increased Security for your money

On 1st June 2003, the Central Bank of Belize put into circulation a modified issue of \$100 and \$20 Belize Currency Notes.

The Central Bank of Belize now introduces the \$50, \$10, \$5 and \$2 of this modified issue of the 1998 upgraded family of banknotes.

The banknotes will be issued into circulation commencing with the \$10 denomination in October 2003. The \$50, \$5, and \$2 will follow by the end of 2003.

The old notes will continue to circulate alongside the new notes until further notice. Should you have a suspect note, compare it to a note you know to be genuine and check that the above security features are present. If you feel that the note may be a counterfeit, take it to the police or Central Bank for verification.
